True Innocents Equine Rescue in California is Verified by the Global Federation of Animal Sanctuaries

April 12, 2012 (Riverside, CA) – The Global Federation of Animal Sanctuaries (GFAS), the only globally recognized organization providing standards for identifying legitimate animal sanctuaries, awarded Verified status to True Innocents Equine Rescue (TIER) as of December 15, 2011.

Verification means that TIER meets the criteria of a true equine sanctuary/rescue and is providing humane and responsible care of the animals. To be awarded Verified status, an organization must meet GFAS's rigorous and peer-reviewed animal care standards which are confirmed by a site visit and they must also adhere to a demanding set of ethical and operational principles.
